BSA Board Email Vote February 21, 2025

The Board voted in favor of signing the Society's name onto a letter to Congress from the Union of Concerned Scientists and several other scientific societies.

This letter asks Congress to:

• Prohibit the freezing of Congressionally-approved and federally-funded science

• Restore a federal grant expert peer review process that is free from "ideological review," and restore cancelled funding streams and grant programs

• Allow government scientists to do their important work, including speaking with the public and collaborating with international colleagues.

• Oppose drastic cuts to the workforces at federal scientific research and funding agencies, and oppose drastic cuts to future grants.

• Protect individual government scientists from being singled out for harassment

• Cease attacks on and restore funding to diversity, equity, and inclusion efforts in the scientific community.
