

## BSA Past President's report: 2021-2022

Duties of the Past President are to contribute to BSA Board meetings, serve on the Executive Committee, attend Council and Annual Business Meetings and Chair the Election Committee and the Corresponding Members Committee.

Duties were fulfilled as stated. (The final report of the BSA Election Committee is duplicated below.)

*Election Committee*—The first call for nominations for BSA Board positions went out to the membership by email in December, 2021. There were at least two other calls prior to Feb. 1, 2022, when nominations were due.

President Elect. The committee received five external nominations for the slate for BSA President Elect and generated three other nominations internally. After contacting nominees as to their interest in running for the position, and subsequent consideration by the Election Committee, two candidates for President Elect were advanced to the membership: Dr. Robert Rugoso, and Dr. Brenda Molano-Flores.

Treasurer – The committee received three external nominations for the slate of candidates and after contacting nominees as to their interest in running for the position, the committee nominated additional candidates and contacted them. In the end, two candidates were advanced to the BSA membership: Austin Mast and Allison Miller.

Publications Director at Large – The committee received three external nominations for the slate of candidates and after contacting nominees as to their interest in running for the position, the committee nominated additional candidates and contacted them. In the end, one candidate was advanced to BSA membership: Emily Sessa, incumbent Publications Director at Large.

Student Representative –The committee received four external nominations. As per BSA policy, all were contacted and all agreed to stand for election.

About 19% of our eligible membership voted.

*Corresponding Members Committee* –There were no corresponding members nominated this year.
